Stella de Gruchy Memorial Trophy for Best Painting

THEME: There is no theme and the artwork will not be categorised.

MEDIUM: Painting, drawing or mixed medium including photography.

ENTRIES: **1 entry** per member. Hung work will be at the discretion of the judges.

JUDGES: Craig Bluett, Brian Badcock and Pat O'Brien from MaDFAS

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- 1)** You must be a financial member of the Marlborough Art Society
- 2)** Works must not have been previously shown in any exhibition organised by the Marlborough Art Society
- 3)** Works must be able to be hung, or if not hung, supported, so that they are ready to be included in the exhibition.
- 4)** The longest side of the artwork must not be bigger than 1.22 metres (or 1220mm or 122cm) - including the frame
- 5)** Each work must be clearly labelled on the back with your name, address, title of the work, medium, and price.
- 6)** A swing label must be attached by string with the same details
- 7)** Works must be your own original art with no copied or tutored work or reproductions
- 8)** There must be no protruding nails, clips, screws, hooks or eyelets on the back of the work. No wet paintings will be accepted.
- 9)** Works will be hung according to generally accepted gallery practice
- 10)** Any packaging to be taken away by member

- 11)** All works must be for sale, commission on sales is standard MAS Members' commission of 22.5%
- 12)** Insurance is the responsibility of the exhibitor
- 13)** A requirement of the Members' Exhibitions is that all exhibitors volunteer to supervise the exhibition at the gallery (or nominate a willing family member/friend). A fee of **\$20** is applicable if not available. The society relies on volunteers to keep the gallery open to visitors.
- 14) The Stella de Gruchy Memorial Trophy** will be awarded for the Best Painting of the Exhibition. "Painting" is defined as the application of pigment to a surface whether done by brush, painting knife or straight pigment (such as oils, acrylic, watercolour, pastel, pencil and ink).
